Tri-State is offering two options for horse recognition.

Please note that a horse may only be nominated once in their lifetime.

Tri-State Horse of the Year – Current Year Performance

Awards in Nine Divisions: American Saddlebred, Hackney Pony, Morgan, Arabian/Half-Arabian, Walking Horse, Ranch Horse, Open Classes, Academy Horse, Schooling Horse.

Criteria: Emphasis on show performance during the **current** year.

Nominations: Any Tri-State member may submit the name of a horse that was nominated with Tri-State in the current year. This nomination should include a paragraph or two about the horse and the following: horse association honors, show record or any other awards the horse received during the current year. Please include a high-quality digital photo file with your nomination.

Tri-State Diamond Award – Lifetime Performance

Awards in Nine Divisions: American Saddlebred, Hackney Pony, Morgan, Arabian/Half-Arabian, Walking Horse, Ranch Horse, Open Classes, Academy Horse, Schooling Horse.

Criteria: This award is to recognize and honor the accomplishments of the retired show horse during their **career** in the show ring.

Nominations: Any Tri-State member may submit the name of **a horse that is still living** and owned by a current Tri-State member. This nomination should include information on divisions the horse has shown in (Gaited, Driving, Pleasure, Equitation, Academy, etc.), horse's versatility, ages of riders, special awards received, an interesting story from the horses show ring days or other information about the horse. Please include a high-quality digital photo file with your nomination.
